March the $1^{\rm st}$, 2015, the $5^{\rm th}$ Design Contest Awards Ceremony was held at the "Apartment at HIMAWARI Hotel", Phnom Penh.

[1] Objective of the Contest

An important key to the problems in developing countries is <u>the economic</u> <u>independence of women and their leadership</u>. In Cambodia, there are still problems such as "the low positioning of women", "few opportunities towards employment for women" and "there are almost no women professional designers".

The objectives of this contest are <u>to provide a place and opportunity for women to be able to become a symbol for all other women through enriching their professional skills as a representative designer for the country, and to promote future leadership amongst other women through providing a professional career as a designer.</u>

[2] Award Ceremony Highlights

DREAM GIRLS and Japanese supporters, and media people gathered together!

Total entries this time have increased to 324 items. Amongst the 129 contest entrants, there are around 80 candidates qualified in the primary selection. In addition, around 220 Cambodian student supporters, both male and female, the sponsors and representatives of cooperative companies (to be described later) and local Japanese residents, all together around 400 people, joined the ceremony. It became the largest historical Award Ceremony.

In Cambodia, an event where women lead is so rare, we had coverage from 3 local

We had Ms. Asami Hohoko, Japanese best-seller writer, who joined as the special guest speaker and made a very warm and cheerful speech directed to young Cambodian men and women. Also in attendance were Mr. Yajima Makoto, the Managing Director of AEON MALL Phnom Penh, from the government, Mr. Director Ek Buntha of the Ministry of Culture and Fine Arts, just as in the previous year, and Ms. So Chenda, the Dean of Royal University of Fine Arts. Many other people attended on behalf of Cambodia and all witnessed the proud moment for Cambodian Women.

This year we invited those who have been active in various fields as judges to examine the designs. Moreover, on the day, 7 jurors were selected from 8 people who attended and were watching closely the proud moment for Cambodian Women.
